Exhibits shall not display, sell, or dispense any items with offensive, profane, and/or drug-related paraphernalia. The display, sale, or dispensing of these or any other items which in the opinion of the Freeport Renaissance Association are inconsistent with the mission of the Freeport Renaissance Association will result in the removal of the vendor. The vendor must check in with a September by the River official on duty before set-up. Security will be the responsibility of the vendor. Freeport Renaissance Association will not be responsible for damage to exhibit for any reason. Exhibitor will be responsible for any trash in his/her area. Trash cans will be placed throughout the area and may be used by the vendors. Exhibitors shall not transfer or sublet the space or any part thereof or permit the same to be used by any other person without the written consent of the event staff. Event staff shall have the right to terminate the contract granted hereunder at any time without liability, upon the refund of the fee paid herewith. Exhibitor will indemnify and hold Freeport Renaissance Association harmless from all costs, losses, damages, or expenses including the expense of litigation and attorney's fees, resulting from any person or property arising out of any act or omission of the vendor of his employees or other representatives. Freeport Renaissance Association and its officers, agents, or members shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage due to theft, fire, accident, electrical outages, or other cause but will use reasonable care to protect the vendor from such loss.
